

Course for agricultural workers

Danish as a second language

Good Danish language skills can help to ensure and improve daily life communication between farmer and employees.

Together with EDUTASIA and with IBL Sprogservice as a partner, we now offer a course in the Danish language for agricultural employees who do not have Danish as their mother tongue and would like to become better at communicating in Danish in everyday life and at work.

You can choose to participate in the course by attending ALT-HR in Aabenraa or online via Teams

On the course we work with Danish in practice and with a focus on oral conversation-training and building active vocabulary. Emphasis will be placed on training and understanding technical terms specifically adapted to agriculture, as well as understanding the Danish mentality and work culture.

The course is offered to agricultural assistants, trainees and possibly spouses. Teaching takes place at different levels so that everyone can participate.

Course start

The first course day is June 29, 2022 at 16.30-20.00.

There are 17 course days of which four times will include professional course.
(no course days in week 29-31 as well as week 42).

Price

7,500 kroner pr. participant. The farmer can apply for VEU allowance for participation in courses, so the price is actually 1,400 kroner per. participant.
